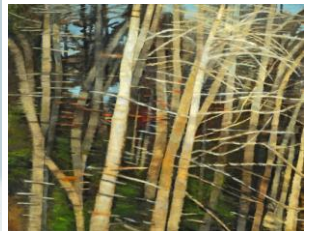

Art about Trees, Roots and Leaves: Since humans started creating art on the walls of caves thousands of years ago, nature has been one of the prime subjects. The artists in this book create art about connectedness, and interdependence -- individuals to trees, human to human, man to nature, individuals to community, and nature to life. Trees inspire uniqueness and relevancy.

Some artists paint them, others sculpt with them, and some even use them for fuel as a catalyst to create new art forms. There are as many different ways to artistically interpret a tree, root, or leaf as there are people. Of course many of the artists paint, but even in that arena they use a wide variety of techniques and applications: oil, acrylic, watercolor, encaustic, mixed media, collage, photography. Some make woodcuts; fabric artists use a wide variety of materials; sculptors use wood or transform other materials into wood or trees. Ceramicists and glass artists work with the subject of trees or make images to resemble wood and trees.
