



New technologies added to older ones present the best in artwork featuring artificial light at Zenith's new show, ***Light Up Your heArt***.

Reaching global heights, neon launched within cities especially in Times Square and Las Vegas as signage. In more recent times, there was a resurgence of neon and light art that propelled artists to incorporate or use neon as the main medium in their works.
